2013 AWPAAUSTRALIAN WHIPCRACKING CHAMPIONSHIPS Event Regulations

Event: The event will be known as the A.W.P.A AUSTRALIAN Whipcracking Championships, sanctioned by the Australian Whipcrackers & Plaiters Association Inc., and promoted by the AWPA, RM WILLIAMS and the 2013 Royal Easter show at the ROYAL AGRICULTURE SOCIETY OF NEW SOUTH WALES. Commencing at 9.00a.m on Sunday, 31st March 2013 at the Amphitheatre & Amphitheatre Lawns. Each entrant will receive 1 free entry pass to the RAS on the competition day.

Eligibility: The event is open to all competitors holding a current yearly AWPA membership and who comply with the rules and regulations of the AWPA. Each competitor is entitled to enter only the most appropriate of the following categories.

Pee Wees 8 years & Under- up to 10 tricks, 30second Freestyle

Juvenile 12 years & Under- 10 tricks, 30second Freestyle

Junior 16 years & Under- 10 tricks, 1 minute Freestyle

Ladies 17 yrs and over -10 tricks, 1 minute Freestyle

Men's 17 years and over—10 tricks, 1 minute Freestyle

Over 45yrs 5 tricks, 1 minute Freestyle

AWPA WORLD Bullock Whip Championship title - 2 minutes

Ages are as of the day of competition.

Entries: Must be made on the official entry form and MUST be accompanied by the appropriate entry fee (in full).

Entries not accompanied by entry fee will not be accepted. Cheques should be made payable to "AWPA" and be lodged by Friday 8th March, 2013 (NO LATE ENTRIES or ENTRIES ON THE DAY)

Due to time restrictions a maximum of 10 competitors only can be accepted in each section. These will be selected by order of receipt of entries.

Entry Fee:

PeeWees - \$10, Juvenile & Junior - \$20 Ladies & Men's - \$30, Over 45yrs - \$10, (Accuracy Inclusive) AWPA WORLD Bullock Whip Championship title - \$20

<u>Prizes</u>: Sashes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th place getters. Cash and prizes to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th. Trophies to Champions in each section.

<u>Registration</u>: Competitors are required to report to the Secretary on the arena **NO LATER THAN 9:00am** on the day of the event to complete their Registration and judging sheets. All competitors will commence with accuracy on the grassed area.

Equipment Entrants may only use Australian Stockwhips. If the judges deem a whip is not in a safe working order, the competitor will be asked to use a replacement whip. A whip at least six foot in length, from keeper to commencement of fall, must be presented for measurement prior to, and then be used by, each competitor in the accuracy component of the competition. (Not applicable to Pee Wee competitors). Any length of whip may be used in other sections of the competition. A competitor may not use a second person or animal during the competition.

Judging

Conduct: Any competitor heard swearing while competing will be disqualified immediately.

Protests: After the scores have been released at the end of each section the individual competitor has 15minutes to lodge official protest with event secretary or nominated person accompanied by a fee of \$20. Head Judges decision is final on day.

CODE OF ETHICS:

Dress: Suitable 'Australian—type costume' including a hat, should be worn. Neat and tidy appearance is suggested. Sneakers, base ball caps, thongs, tee-shirts and other inappropriate clothing will result in the deduction of points in presentation.

Whips: Whips other than Australian Stockwhips will not be allowed. All whips must be safe to use and should be presented in a well maintained condition.

Manners: Competitors should acknowledge the judges before and after their performance and at all times conduct themselves in a sporting way. Competitors in each event under progression must wait in a designated area while that competition is taking place.

Alcohol/Drugs: No competitor is to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs during the competition.
